


MO MONEY MUSICAL

PROGRAM CURRICULUM

Objective: The program is designed to teach young people how to become producers rather than consumers within society. We do this by teaching financial literacy and business development workshops.

 - Students will practice skills that reflect an appreciation of money that will lead to becoming responsible adults.
 - Students will be able to learn basic skills in starting and maintaining a business.
 - Students will learn basic skills in branding and marketing a business.
 - Students will learn basic skills on partnerships and investors.
 - Students will learn leadership skills and self-awareness.
